



Prof. Dr. Till Requate

- Prof. Dr. Requate has been a member of the German Federal Government’s Commission of Experts for Research and Innovation since 1 May 2020. He holds the Chair of Innovation, Competition Policy and New Institutional Economics at the Christian-Albrechts-Universität zu Kiel.
- Till Requate studied Mathematics and Philosophy at Bielefeld University, where he earned his doctorate in economics with a dissertation on game theory and industrial organization and then completed his habilitation with contributions to environmental economics. After serving as a visiting professor of economic theory at the University of Oldenburg, he was appointed Professor of Environmental Economics at the University of Heidelberg from 1996 to 2002. There he headed the interdisciplinary Institute for Environmental Economics and was Chair of the Research Training Group Environmental and Resource Economics from 1998 to 2002.
- Since 2002, Till Requate has been Professor of Economics in Kiel, where he was Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Social Sciences from mid-2016 to mid-2020. His main research specialties include environmental economics, in particular with focus on incentives for innovation through environmental policy instruments, and experimental economics.
- Professor Requate has won several scientific awards, including the Eric Kempe Prize of the European Association of Environmental and Resource Economists in 2004 and the Best Paper Award of the German Society for Health Economics in 2013. In addition to numerous stays abroad (e. g. at the University of California at San Diego, the California Institute of Technology and the University of Wisconsin), Till Requate was editor-in-chief of the Journal of Environmental Economics and Management from 2013 to 2018 and associate editor of various other economic journals (e. g. European Economic Review, Resource and Energy Economics). He has worked as a consultant for the OECD, the World Bank, InWent and various ministries.
